A Short history of Quilts of Valour Australia Inc.

Following the tragic loss and injury of Defence personnel in Afghanistan in 2010, a resident of Victoria learnt of the need to reach out to wounded ADF personnel and honour their sacrifice for serving Australia on a combat deployment. It is such a powerful symbol in a traumatic time that it felt an important issue that Australians should be involved. Victorian resident, Helen Comport, learnt how touched an injured soldier was by the warmth of the quilt he was awarded by American 'Quilts of Valor'.

Helen was inspired to establish an Australian organisation . Through consultation with the American group and support from the Victorian Quilters Guild and the Berwick RSL sub-branch, the first official meeting with election of office bearers occurred in February 2012.

We have co-ordinators and representatives in every Australian state and Territory.

Quilts of Valour Australia Inc. has awarded quilts to Defence personnel touched by war and the immediate families of fallen soldiers since the beginning of 2012.

We supplied quilts to the military in Afghanistan to be awarded by the RSM as soldiers were wounded. We have also sent quilts to the military hospital in Germany. All families of soldiers who have paid the ultimate sacrifice in Afghanistan have been made aware of 'Quilts of Valour Australia' and over 100 quilts have been awarded to these family members. We award quilts to veterans from all conflicts as we know that they all carry the scars of war. As we grow around Australia we are hopeful that more quilting groups will learn about our cause and get involved.

The quilts are awarded with a covering letter and certificate to the recipient. The quilt is a powerful gift of love. The top of the quilt with its many colours, shapes and fabrics, represents the communities and the many individuals we are. The wadding, the filler, is the centre of the quilt, its warmth. It represents our hope that this quilt will bring warmth, comfort, peace and healing to the recipient. The backing is the strength that supports the communities, and our nation. Each stitch that holds the layers together represents love, gratitude and sometimes the tears of the maker.
